or in the street!



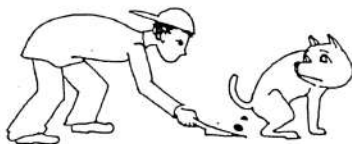
- Turn off water spigots

them!



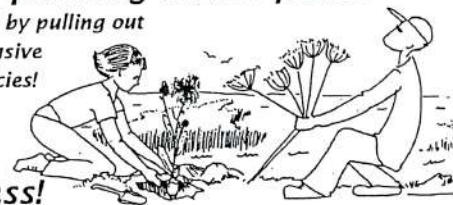
- fix leaking cars!
